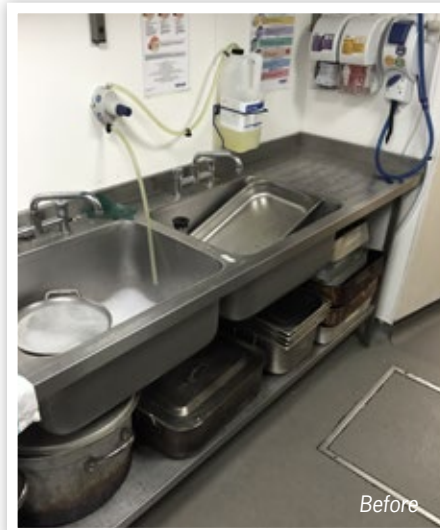

THE SITUATION BEFORE.

The hotel restaurant was doing their pot and pan washing in a decarboniser and 3 sink system, letting utensils soak for hours before they could be scrubbed clean. The equipment was outdated and both a waste of effort and energy, according to Jim SHIELDS the Director of Engineering at Marriott.

GRANULDISK offered a one month trial period to convince managers of the superiority of the No Pre-washing™ concept from GRANULDISK.

The water consumption was measured during 6 months before the Granule Smart® from GRANULDISK was installed in order to have a baseline for the comparison.

THE SITUATION AFTER.

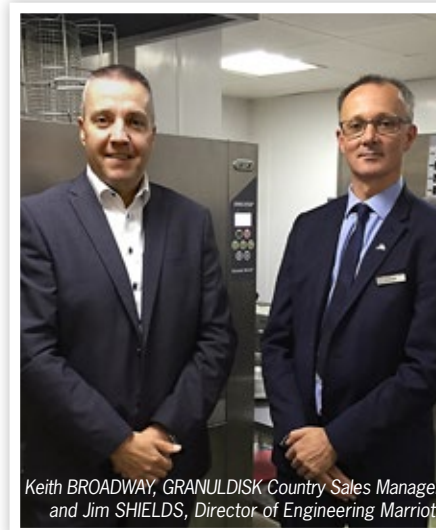
With approximately 2500 meals/day the kitchen porters quickly took to using the Granule Smart® pot washer, with the capacity to wash 180 GN 1/1 trays per hour without any need for soaking or scrubbing.

Now, they run about 57 wash programmes a day, using only 512 litres of water daily for the potwashing. This is roughly 8 % of what the water consumption was before.

In addition, the new space saving setup allows for all dishwashing to be done in the same area which makes it more manageable for the kitchen. Last but not least, the wash result is impeccable.

London Heathrow Marriott Sustainability Initiatives

The London Heathrow Marriott has taken a number of steps towards making the hotel as sustainable as possible and by doing so reducing their Carbon footprint substantially. This includes investing in different equipment and devices to reduce energy and water consumption as well as implementing recycling schemes so that 100 % of the hotel waste is recycled. The hotel has it's own windmill and a greenhouse to grow herbs and tomatoes on the rooftop. It also participates in global initiatives for climate change awareness.
